LTAIG Bursary Guidelines

- 1. WHO can apply
 - a. Library technicians
 - b. Library assistants
 - c. Other library staff (eg. library administrative staff)
- 2. WHERE does this apply
 - a. For residents of NL only
- 3. Funds are awarded, on a competitive basis, to individuals who have applied to have the cost covered for the following professional opportunities:
 - To continue professional library technician diploma requirements or continue education with Library Technician subject specific courses from an accredited institution (eg. NSCC or Mohawk College)
 - b. To do training seminars, workshops or other education related to your job duties or responsibilities
 - c. To attend a provincial library association conference (eg. NLLA or LTAIG)
- 4. WHAT the funding will cover
 - a. The cost of travel and accommodations associated with conference attendance
 - b. Tuition or fees associated with training or education
- 5. To qualify, members must be:
 - a. employed in the province of Newfoundland and Labrador in a library/archive/museum related field and have worked in that field for at least one year
 - b. Must have prior authorization to attend or take part in training/workshop/course work etc. from supervisor/employer
 - c. Must be a member of NLLA or include membership application and fees with this application
- 6. Members are welcome to apply more than once; however, no member shall be awarded the bursary in two (2) consecutive years
- 7. The reviewing of applications and awarding of the bursary will be made by a committee of (3) Library Technician/Assistant volunteers or appointed by the NLLA Executive and chaired by the LTAIG representative.
